



Application Procedures and Criteria

Purpose

China AIDS Fund awards a limited number of grants each year. The grants are intended to promote the treatment and prevention of HIV/AIDS in China.

Issue Areas

Criteria

Applications for a China AIDS Fund grant will be evaluated in terms of:

- ✓ Potential to better the lives of people living with HIV/AIDS in China
- ✓ Innovative qualities of the proposed project
- ✓ Project feasibility and likelihood of success
- ✓ Ability to document, measure, and disseminate project achievements
- ✓ Soundness of proposed project management and staff
- ✓ Ability of the applicant to provide partial project financing, in-kind organizational support, and on-going funding at the completion of the project
- ✓ Potential for project replication

Application Requirements

China AIDS Fund grants are awarded to not-for-profit organizations; they are not awarded to individuals. Accordingly, applications must bear the signature of an official authorized to sign for the organization and, if requested, the applicant institution must submit proof of its not-for-profit status. Organizations located overseas must submit proof that they are equivalent of a U.S. 501 (c)(3) organization. Applications are neither requested nor accepted from for-profit entities.

Grants may be given in support of a portion of the direct costs of a project. Funds are not available for the following:

- Overhead or other indirect costs.
- Capital costs (such as construction, acquisition, or renovation of facilities)
- The purchase, lease, rental or servicing of office equipment

Performance Reporting

To help us evaluate China AIDS Fund grants and share project results with relevant audiences, all funded projects are required to submit at least one interim report prior to the final summary assessment and report. In the interim and final reports, grantees must also provide an accurate
