

2024 Future Asian American Leadership Scholarship

I. Scholarship Details:

Scholarships are for **FIVE** high school senior students entering an accredited four-year college in the fall of 2024.

Award Amount: Tuition scholarship, \$3,000 each

Distribution Method: A check will be sent directly to the college or university to assist the award recipient with enrollment expenses.

Scholarship focus: Need-Based Scholarship

II. Selection Criteria To Be Considered:

- Must be a full-time High School student expected to graduate Class of 2024.
- Must be of Asian Ethnicity as defined by the US Census.
- Priority is given to those with financial need. Financial data must be submitted as evidence of financial need. Applicant must submit a copy of their parent/guardian's IRS income tax return for the past two years (2021 and 2022)
- Evidence of student's outstanding academic performance. Must have a 3.5 or higher GPA.
- Extracurricular/Community Service: List any extracurricular activities, community service, or leadership roles you have been involved in during high school. (Max 300 words)
- Academic Achievements: List any academic achievements, honors, or awards you have received during high school. (Max 300 words)
- One letter of recommendation: Must provide letter of recommendation from someone who has personal knowledge of the student such as a teacher or student advisor.

• Briefly describe your career goals and how the scholarship will help you achieve them. (12-point font, Times New Roman, double spaced, 3 paragraphs, 300–400-word count).

III. Application Materials

- Completed Scholarship Application
- A headshot of themselves: JPEG, PNG, HEIC
- Evidence of Financial Need Applicant must submit a copy of their parent/guardian's IRS income tax return for the past two years (2021 and 2022).
 - If the applicant does not have the above-mentioned tax forms, he/she needs to provide any supplement supporting document(s) demonstrating financial need.
- Official school transcript.
- One letter of recommendation.
- Essay or personal statement to briefly describe your career goals and how the scholarship will help you achieve them. (12-point font, Times New Roman, double spaced, 3 paragraphs, 300–400-word count)
- All other materials applicant will include to show extracurricular involvement, leadership, or special qualification.
- Due Date: Postmark by April 15, 2024
